

## **From Our Pastor**

Dear Church,

For the last 6 months I have been writing and preaching that a building doesn't make us the church, that **we, the body of Christ, are the church**.

Sometimes the church gathers in a building, and other times we gather in our cars, on a living room couch, at a kitchen table, in a neighbor's driveway, or at a park. Wherever we are, the church is. If these last 6 months have taught me, and I hope you, anything, it's that a virus cannot stop the church from being who we are called to be... the body of Christ in the world.



A couple of weeks ago I sent you a survey asking how you are feeling about returning to worship in the building. Thank you for responding. What the council and I have learned from you is that many of you are ready to return to the building now, with Covid-19 protocols in place, knowing that worship will feel different, be different.

Beginning Sunday, October 4, at 10am we will return to a worship service in the Joy building (maximum 50 people). Our FM transmitter will be on and will allow those who are not ready to worship inside the building a way to tune in to FM 87.9 from the parking lot and worship.

Beginning Thursday, October 8, at 1pm we will offer a small (maximum 15 people) worship service specifically for those who have compromised immune systems or are otherwise at a higher risk of infection. We kindly ask you to make a reservation for this service. We will continue to offer this as there is a need.

We will continue to offer online worship, indefinitely.


These are strange times we are living in, but the church is called to strange times. So in October whether you're sitting in a pew or in your car or on your couch to worship, remember that we are the church. Together.

#### W/ELCA News

It was decided at our meeting on September 16 to hold an Outdoor Bazaar this year. It will be on Saturday, October 24, from 10am to noon in the church parking lot. We plan to have tent canopies. Lefse will be scaled down this year with only 2 days of making it. The dates for making lefse are Monday, October 5, and Monday, October 12. we will need volunteers (women, men, teens) to make it for the morning shift which is from 8:30-10:30am; the afternoon shift from 3:30-4:30pm; and the evening shift from 6pm until done. The times are approximate. No experience necessary, we will train! If you have lefse making equipment, and would like to share it, that would be helpful.

We would appreciate donations of homemade canned produce, such as pickles, jams, jellies, etc.; baked goods (pies, cakes, breads, etc.); quilts or other handmade items.

Lunch will not be served. Please do not bring any clothing items or white elephant items.

If you are able to help with lefse, setting up or taking down on Friday or Saturday, please call either Sandy Christensen at 715-381-3765 or Carol Johnson at 715-825-3114.

We welcome and appreciate any and all participation in the event!

The following are topics and issues the Joy council addressed at the regular monthly meeting on Thursday, September 10:

- Renters for and/or renting the parsonage.
- Council sponsored Drive-Thru Dinner on October 3. Menu is pulled pork, bun, beans, coleslaw, chips, dessert and beverage. Profit designated to the emergency food shelf, Luther Point Bible Camp, and the Joy Generosity Fund.
- Beginning to put plans in place for returning to in person worship. Approval
  of survey for congregation. Council to evaluate results of survey in zoom
  meeting prior to October meeting.
- Council votes to establish a Generosity Fund. Guidelines will be developed for the use of the fund.
- Scholarship applications and applicants presented. Scholarships are awarded at the end of each year for use at second semester.

#### Pastor's Report—as given to Council on September 10, 2020

- Mary, Deanna, and I keep devising new and interesting ways to work and keep members connected to what's happening at/through Joy.
- Members and friends continue to give financially and generously to the mission of the church.
- Members and friends continue to give generously of their time and talents: Painting, organizing, and creating wonderful and welcoming spaces for gathering.
- ♦ The emergency food pantry continues to provide food to people in need.
- ♦ The sick are being visited (or called, as is the case these days when an in-person visit isn't an option, or advisable).
- Communion visits are being made.
- Wedding couples have had many hours of pre-marital pastoral care.
- We've engaged in 6 months of online worship services.
- We have two additional Drive-In worship services scheduled for September.
- The Mid-week Meet-ups via Zoom have ended for now.

I am part of a group which has developed a collaborative confirmation program for this unique year. We are partnering with several congregations, pastors, and Luther Point Bible Camp. The program is called Narratology. We will meet in a variety of ways, including large group meetings the 1st Wednesday of each month via Zoom. Then there will be in-person, small group/individual congregation meetings 1 or 2 times a month (Corona permitting), and 1 time a month will be a family night at home. Narratology offers 9 lessons per year covering scripture and catechism. There is a special Narratology website as well as a google classroom we will use. Everything students and families will need for confirmation will be found easily on the Joy Lutheran Church website under the Confirmation link.

One of my colleagues told me about something they have tried this month, called Faith Circles. These are a short (small group) bible study, with brief order for confession and forgiveness and communion. Each is a stand alone study, so perfect for unpredictable week-by-week schedules. Sign up required. I am considering something like this for Joy.

Faith5 has begun. Pre-recording a greeting to the kids from me. Info for the first month is on the Joy website under F5. This month's lessons are called "Best Year Ever." Families are working on the lessons at home together. I hope to be back to live or Zoom with families in October.

October 25, Reformation Sunday, we hope to celebrate the Affirmation of Baptism for our two 2nd year students: Allison Gingras and Kendra Wheeler. I am working with the families on this. Whether we pre-record the service and have just the families in the sanctuary and use during our online service, or if we've begun worshipping in the sanctuary, then we will do it "old school," meaning together in the sanctuary.
