GUEST PREACHER | PR. DIANE HOUSE | SUNDAY MAY 5TH Diane House, Director of Evangelical Mission for the Northwest Synod of Wisconsin

In my role as DEM, I work in the area of stewardship and generosity, congregational vitality, guide the work of Deacon Lidixe Montoya who is our mission developer of the Neighbor2Neighbor ministry, and also in area strategies and the call process. In other and less "churchy" words: my call is to help all the congregations of the synods to become mission outposts in their communities and to help all people be disciples of Jesus in all they say and do!

I have met with Joy's generosity team twice to dwell in scripture together and to discern what God is calling this congregation to do with it's abundant blessings. These blessings include the time we have to volunteer, the skills we have to share as we work together, and our money to finance the work. Next we turn to some authors that can guide us in stewardship to decide together how to best encourage the congregation to be generous with their abundant gifts.

- 2. Ask, Thank, Tell, Improving Stewardship Ministry in Your Congregation by Charles R. Lane

These two books are a good guide for encouraging and empowering the gifts of generosity in your congregation. Let's talk more about all the abundant gifts God has given you and how you are called to share them within the community and the world!
