***Proper sanitation** of church dishes - [Erin presented information regarding handwashing dishes. We must use the dishwasher for all dishes according to our food service license. Handwashing would require the 3-sink system with washing, rinsing and sanitizing being done. If there are a few dirty dishes they should be put in a rack on the dishwasher and when it is full the dishwasher can be used to wash them all at once.
