Application must be typed, and all requirements must be included.

Scholarship recipients will be announced by September 15, for use in the current school year.

Scholarships will be awarded the Sunday after Christmas.

Award of any and all scholarships will be at the discretion of the Church Council, acting on the recommendation of the Scholarship Committee. Maximum total awards, as determined by the Scholarship Committee, will be divided equally between the recipients for any year in which scholarships are awarded.
